Topic/Theme: Effective Buying of Strategic IT Solutions

Purchasing IT solutions is, in most cases, a strategic decision that has long-term impact on your organization. Strategic actions and steps, IT professionals and leaders can put into play, which are not thought to typically be in their toolbox, can drive cost and improve the value proposition for the organization. A strategic procurement process will be discussed covering; the developing requirements and using the requirements document, negotiations (create a case for acting and thinking "Negotiate" during the entire procurement process), when and when not to go out for bid. Then, specific actions, irrespective of whether you bid or not, to increase the vendor's competitive tension, including the executive's involvement in face to face discussions, will be examined.

**Speakers:** Hank Zimmerman is a purchasing and procurement professional, manager and consultant with a focus in IT and industrial services and software. He is a seasoned negotiator with the demonstrated ability to develop and execute purchasing and negotiating strategies, which blend with and support overriding business goals and produce significant savings. 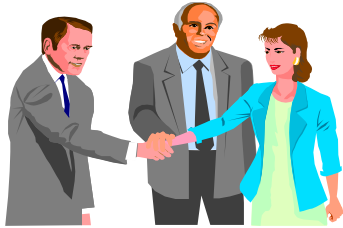
