**Presentation:** NCR Corporation Embraces IP Telephony Internally Sam Coursen, CIO of NCR Corporation, is leading his IT team through a companywide, global conversion to IP Telephony (IPT) that many CIOs have pondered but have yet to implement. Mr. Coursen will present the drivers behind this technology change within NCR; the business case for IPT and the resulting cost savings/return on investment; criteria/parameters for vendor selection; timing for international rollout; and lessons learned.

**About the Speaker:** Sam Coursen is Vice President and Chief Information Officer of NCR Corporation (NYSE: NCR) and a member of the company's Business Leaders Council. He is responsible for the discovery, development, and delivery of quality information technology services and solutions that optimize the operational effectiveness and market performance of NCR. The Information Technology Services organization within NCR is comprised of employees based around the world.

Coursen joined NCR in 1993 and has held various senior management positions within the company. He was appointed Services Development Vice President in 1995, responsible for development and global deployment of external NCR service offerings, including professional services and customer support services. In 1997, he was named Global Applications Vice President, overseeing development and global deployment of the IT applications supporting NCR's internal business operations. Prior to NCR, Coursen held various technical and management positions at AT&T.

Coursen holds a bachelor's degree in Electrical Engineering from Auburn University

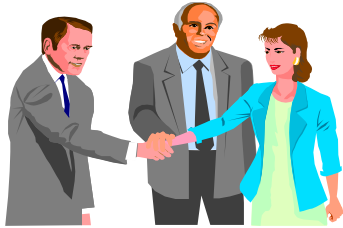
